## ■ DAY 1

### Budapest, Hungary / Embark Ship

Arrive in Budapest and embark *Evolve*. ## ◇ DAY 2

### Budapest

Begin your day with a guided tour of Budapest's beloved Christmas markets. Wander through the vibrant stalls of Vörösmarty Square, St. Stephen's Basilica and Andrassy Avenue, each brimming with handcrafted gifts, seasonal treats and holiday cheer. Conclude your stroll at the Budapest Central Market Hall, the largest and oldest indoor market in the city.

This afternoon, enjoy an exclusive visit to the prestigious Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music, the heart of Hungary's rich musical heritage. Enjoy rare access to its Art Nouveau concert halls and historical teaching rooms while learning about the life and legacy of composer Franz Liszt. The experience culminates in a private salon concert featuring a rising virtuoso or student ensemble—an intimate showcase of Hungary's next generation of musical talent. Cap off the day with an unforgettable Christmas Eve dinner, complete with live Hungarian entertainment.

## ◇ DAY 3

### Sailing / Bratislava, Slovak Republic

Gather for a festive Christmas lunch, featuring traditional dishes from Hungary, Austria and the Slovak Republic. Relax with coffee and a book or refresh with a visit to the gym during the afternoon. Later, enjoy a tasting of sparkling wines that showcase the best of local vintages. As night falls, arrive in Bratislava, the capitol of the Slovak Republic, where you can attend a joyous Christmas mass if you wish. On board, Christmas dinner awaits, followed by an evening of live entertainment featuring a traditional Slovakian band, bringing the spirit of the season to life through music and celebration.

## ◇ DAY 4

### Bratislava

Begin your day with an unforgettable private chamber concert in one of Bratislava's most historical venues—either the elegant Reduta Hall or the opulent Golden Salon of Grassalkovich Palace. The renowned Cappella Istropolitana orchestra will perform classical masterpieces by Mozart and Haydn in one of these intimate, atmospheric settings.

Later, enjoy a curated visit to the newly reopened Salvator Pharmacy, a hidden gem designed in Baroque fashion that dates back to 1727. Marvel

at its original cabinet of curiosities, rare medicinal artifacts and richly preserved interiors. Experience a cellar-side tasting of Slovak spirits or artisanal bitters—a flavorful journey into the region’s gastronomic heritage. Return to *Evolve* for an elegant Slovak dinner.

◇ DAY 5

### Krems, Austria

Wake up this morning to Krems, a UNESCO World Heritage site in the heart of the Wachau Valley. In Salzburg, you’ll discover the city’s holiday spirit amid the artisan booths of its renowned Christmas market, surrounded by the majestic Alps. Enjoy lunch at a traditional Austrian restaurant, savoring regional specialties in a cozy setting.

Alternatively, venture to Český Krumlov, a UNESCO-listed town known for its medieval architecture and storybook charm. During the holiday season, its cobbled streets and castle views are adorned with festive lights and market stalls,

creating a magical atmosphere. Explore the town and savor a traditional lunch at a local restaurant.

◇ DAY 7

### Passau, Germany

Experience the charm of Passau, a picturesque Bavarian town where the Danube, Inn and Ilz converge. Start at Domplatz, home to the magnificent St. Stephen’s Cathedral, famous for its Baroque splendor. Witness a private performance of the world’s largest cathedral organ, featuring over 17,000 pipes. Continue through the winding alleys and vibrant facades of the old town before enjoying a free afternoon to explore on your own. Conclude your day with a savory German dinner, featuring regional Bavarian dishes and beers.

◇ DAY 8

### Grein, Austria / Melk

Take a private tour of Clam Castle, a majestic medieval fortress rich in Austrian history that overlooks the Danube Valley. Gain rare access to private areas, including the Renaissance arcaded courtyard, the Gothic chapel with Baroque flourishes, the armory and select residential apartments that have been lived in since 1454. Hear captivating stories of the castle’s role in Austrian history, including how it was defended during the Thirty Years’ War.

Later, experience the grandeur of Melk Abbey—a UNESCO World Heritage site—during an after-hours visit. Wander the Baroque Library, Marble Hall, Imperial Staircase and the awe-inspiring Abbey Church, all without the usual crowds. Weather permitting, stroll through the Abbey Park, home to 250-year-old linden trees and a Baroque garden pavilion adorned with frescoes by Johann Baptist Wenzel Bergl. Conclude your day with

a medieval-style dinner on board inspired by traditional Austrian fare.

◇ DAY 9

## Vienna

One of the largest palaces in Europe, Schönbrunn was the main summer residence of the powerful Habsburg dynasty for over 300 years and a hub of courtly life. At the Albertina Museum, discover a unique blend of imperial history and world-class art from masters like Raphael, da Vinci, Picasso and Monet. Enjoy time on your own, exploring Vienna's museums, cafés and beautifully lit streets.

Ring in the New Year this evening with an unforgettable gala dinner. Savor a multi-course feast accompanied by live classical and contemporary music. This festive onboard event, capped off with fireworks at midnight, captures the magic of Vienna at year's end.

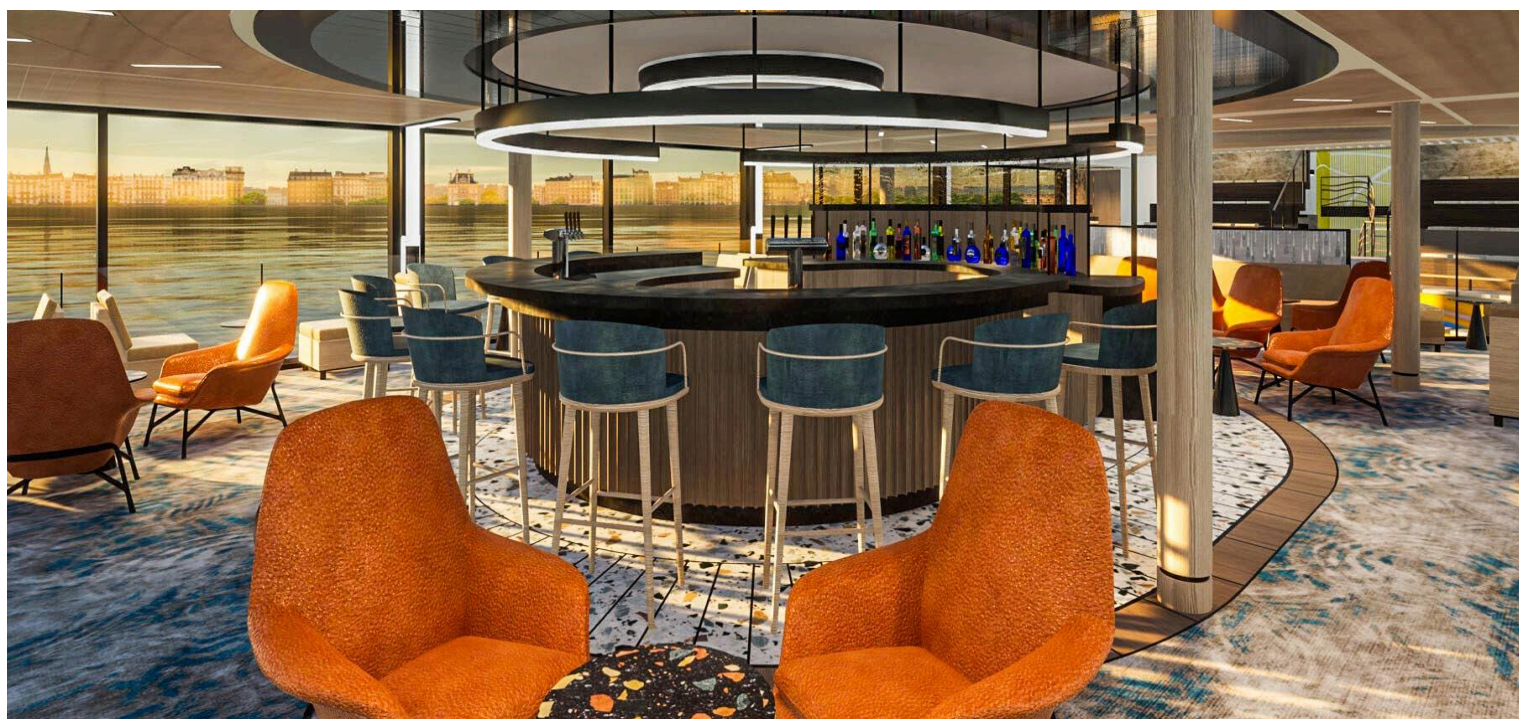
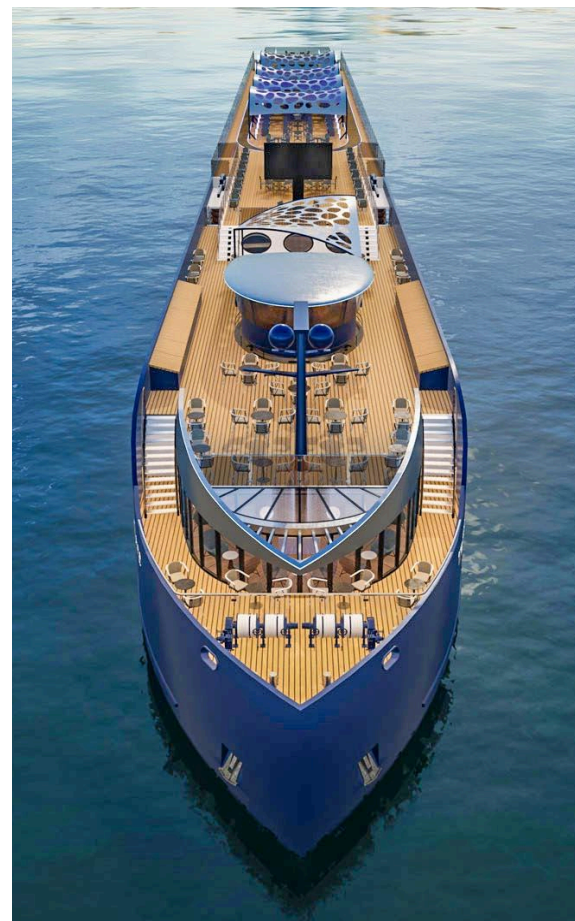
Constructed in 2026, *Evolve* is a brand-new, state-of-the-art European river ship joining our growing collection of bespoke charter vessels.

Every detail is thoughtfully designed—from carefully sourced build materials and green technology that minimizes food waste to environmentally friendly bath and bedding products.

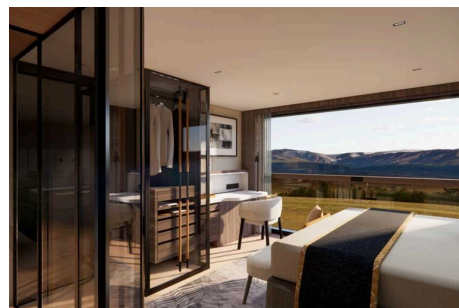


# Cabin Categories

## Category C1

MAIN DECK #217-220, 225-231

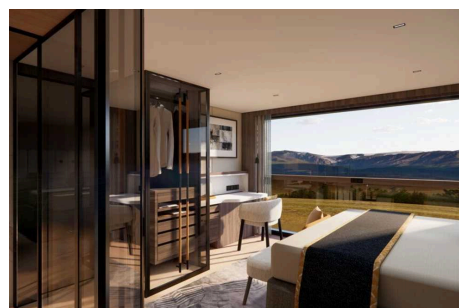
These 210-square-foot cabins located at the back of the Main Deck feature floor-to-ceiling windows, sash window balcony and quiet sleep sound cancellation system. The cabins each have a European king bed or two twin beds (configured upon request), a 55-inch smart TV, desk and chair, minibar, individual climate control and two wardrobes.



## Category C2

MAIN DECK #202, 204, 209-216

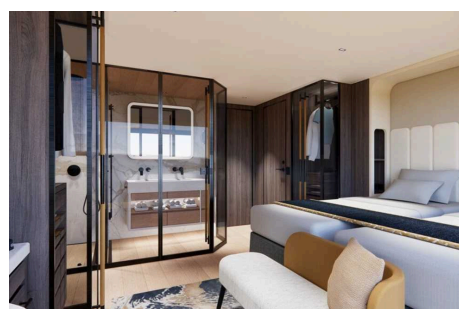
These 210-square-foot cabins located at the front of the Main Deck feature floor-to-ceiling windows, sash window balcony and quiet sleep sound cancellation system. The cabins each have a European king bed or two twin beds (configured upon request), a 55-inch smart TV, desk and chair, minibar, individual climate control and two wardrobes. Two category C2 cabins can be combined into a category S2 Suite.



## Category F1

MAIN DECK #F221, F222

These 420-square-foot two-bedroom family suites are located at the back of the Main Deck. Each bedroom features floor-to-ceiling windows, sash window balconies and quiet sleep sound cancellation system. Each cabin has a European king bed or two twin beds (configured upon request), 55-inch smart TV, desk and chair, minibar, individual climate control and ample storage including four wardrobes.

MAIN DECK #S201, S205, S206

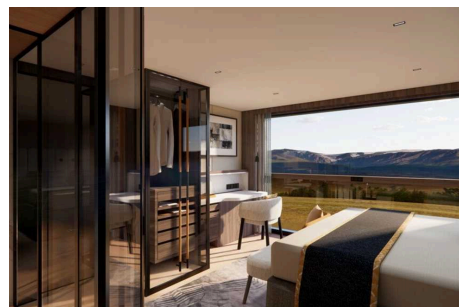

## Category C3

UPPER DECK #318, 320, 325-331

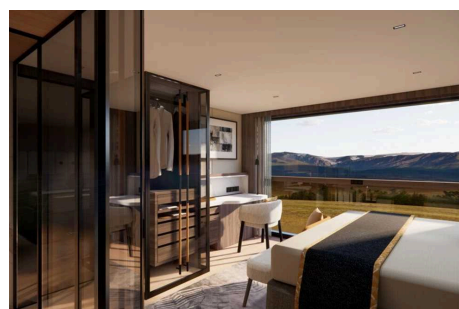

Two category C3 cabins can be combined into a category S3 Suite.



## Category C4

UPPER DECK #302, 304, 309-316

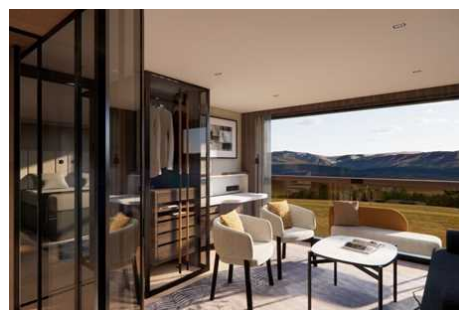

UPPER DECK #S317, S321, S322

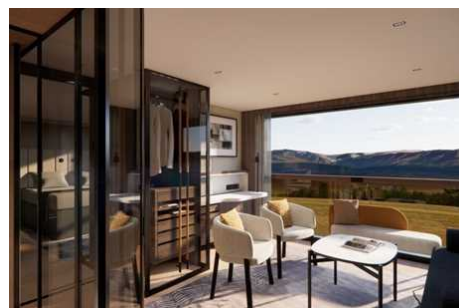

## Category S4

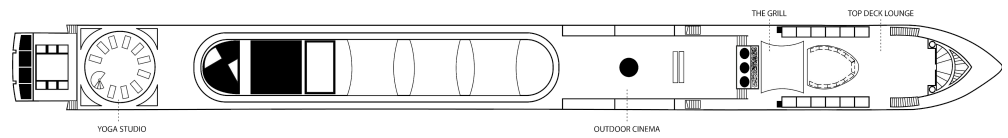
UPPER DECK #S301, S305, S306
